RESOLUTION NO. 3755, S-2026

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE CITY MAYOR CARMELITA A. ABALOS TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT (DSWD) FOR THE PROJECT LAWA (LOCAL ADAPTATION TO WATER ACCESS) AND BINHI (BREAKING INSUFFICIENCY THROUGH NUTRITIOUS HARVEST FOR THE IMPOVERISHED) UNDER ITS RISK RESILIENCY PROGRAM-CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION AND MITIGATION (RRP-CCAM)

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10121 designated the DSWD as Vice-Chairperson for Disaster Response of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC);

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the said law provides among others, maximum care, assistance and services to individuals and families affected by disaster. It also mandated the implementation of preparedness and emergency rehabilitation projects to lessen the impact of disaster and facilitate resumption of normal social and economic activities;

WHEREAS, in response to increasing risk and exposure to hazards, exacerbated by climate change impacts, the Risk Resiliency Program (RRP) was created by the DSWD as a more climate responsive intervention program following the gradual onset of El Nino in 2024. It prioritized ensuring water availability and food security through LAWA and BINHI (Local Adaptation to Water Access and Breaking Insufficiency through Nutritious Harvest for the Impoverished) Project;

WHEREAS, under the LAWA and BINHI project, beneficiaries will be trained in the following: planting of climate-and-disaster-resilient crops and fruit-bearing trees, water sufficiency through construction of water harvesting facilities, ecological and environmental preservation; and other activities in line with the approved Local Climate Change Action Plan (LCCAP), Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (LDRRMP), and other Local Development Plans;

WHEREAS, in 2025, the DSWD partnered with the City of Mandaluyong for its LAWA at BINHI project, through the execution of a Memorandum of Agreement by virtue of Sanggunian Resolution No. 3613, S-2025;

WHEREAS, for the year 2026, the DSWD once again selected the City of Mandaluyong to be its partner for the implementation of the LAWA and BINHI project, with the City set to receive Six Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P6,950,000.00) as its budget allocation for five hundred (500) eligible beneficiaries;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the General Welfare Provision of the Local Government Code, every Local Government Unit must ensure the promotion of health and safety of its constituents;

WHEREAS, the City of Mandaluyong expressed its willingness to once again participate in the said program;

WHEREAS, to outline the responsibilities of both Parties similar with the previous engagements, a Memorandum of Agreement must be executed;


WHEREAS, Section 22 of the Local Government Code gives Mandaluyong City, as represented by its Local Chief Executive, the power to enter into contracts, after being authorized by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to authorize the Honorable Mayor CARMELITA A. ABALOS to enter into and sign the Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) for the Project LAWA (Local Adaptation to Water Access) and BINHI (Breaking Insufficiency through Nutritious Harvest for the Impoverished) under its Risk Resiliency Program-Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation (RRP-CCAM).

RESOLVED FINALLY, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Office of the Mayor, Department of Social Welfare and Development, and other pertinent departments and offices of the City Government of Mandaluyong.
