ORDINANCE NO. 741, S-2019

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR BENEFITS TO BE GIVEN TO ATHLETES, COACHES/TRAINERS AND PWD ATHLETES WHO REPRESENTED THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG AND HAVE PLACED AT LEAST IN THE TOP THREE OF THEIR RESPECTIVE EVENTS IN ANY REGIONAL, NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIONS

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 17 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that "The State shall give priority to education, science and technology, arts, culture and sports to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerate social progress, and promote total human liberation and development";

WHEREAS, Article XIV, Section 19 (1) of the same fundamental law further provides that "The State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry";

WHEREAS, despite the noble intention of the aforementioned State Policies, there is no adequate law that will provide for any assurance guaranteeing the benefits befitting the country's hardworking athletes which may have indirectly resulted in Philippines' lagging at the bottom of international sports competition;

WHEREAS, the City of Mandaluyong, through the able leadership and foresight of the Honorable Mayor Carmelita A. Abalos, and represented by the youth athletes of the City have excelled in various domestic and in some cases, international sports competition;

WHEREAS, for bringing honor and prestige to the name of the City of Mandaluyong, the Honorable City Mayor deems it right to provide due compensation in the form of scholarships, grants or cash incentives whenever appropriate to these deserving athletes, many of whom belong to the impoverished sector of the City's residents.

BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong in Regular Session duly assembled:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as "ATHLETES' COMPENSATION PROGRAM".

SECTION 2. COVERAGE.

1. Athletes representing the City of Mandaluyong
2. Coaches/trainers of athletes representing the City in sports competition
3. PWD Athletes Winner representing the City of Mandaluyong

SECTION 3. EXTENT OF COVERAGE.

The athletes, coaches/trainers who may be entitled to the incentives granted by this Ordinance shall be those who have landed in the top three performing athletes of their respective events, that is, who have earned a bronze, silver and/or gold medals.

SECTION 4. SPORTS COMPETITION COVERED:

A. National

1. Philippine Nationals
2. Palarong Pambansa
3. Batang Pinoy

B. International

Any other sporting events which the Mandaluyong Sports Development Office may choose to join other than those mentioned in Letters A and B may be automatically covered by the scope of this Ordinance, subject to the approval of the City Mayor.

SECTION 5. INCENTIVES OF ATHLETES IN NATIONAL COMPETITIONS.

Gold - ₱10,000.00

Silver - ₱ 5,000.00

Bronze - ₱ 3,000.00

An athlete who may have won multiple medals in a single sport shall, likewise, be entitled to multiple incentives in a decremental manner.

Example: Gold = ₱10,000.00; Silver = ₱5,000.00; Bronze = ₱3,000.00

Athlete A:

First Gold = ₱10,000.00 (maybe for individual event)

Second Gold = ₱8,000.00 (maybe for team event) and so on...

Athlete B:

First Gold = ₱10,000.00

First Silver/Bronze = ₱5,000.00/₱3,000.00

Second Silver/Bronze = ₱3,000.00/₱2,000.00 and so on...

An athlete who may have won multiple medals in various sports shall receive the amount corresponding to the value of the medals won.

SECTION 6. INCENTIVES OF COACHES.

Gold - ₱5,000.00

Silver - ₱3,000.00

Bronze - ₱2,000.00

Coaches and Athletes having multiple medals regardless of events and medals won will have the maximum ceiling of ₱20,000.00 both international and national competitions.

SECTION 7. ALTERNATIVE INCENTIVES OF ATHLETES IN LIEU OF CASH SUBJECT TO THE DISCRETION OF THE CITY MAYOR. An athlete who has qualified to receive cash incentives may be given partial/full scholarship grant or educational assistance, the amount of which is to be determined by the City's Executive Department in charge with the implementation of the scholarship program.

SECTION 8. OTHER FORM OF INCENTIVE.

All athletes, irrespective of whether they win a medal or not should be covered with an accident or death insurance every year prior to joining the game.

SECTION 9. SOURCE OF FUNDS.

The cash incentives as well as the amount for the payment of the premium for accident/death insurance covered by this Ordinance shall be taken from the Mayor's Social Fund. The fund to be used shall be sourced from the General Fund specifically Social Fund under Mayor's Office while the amount to be paid for the scholarship of athletes shall be charged against Gender and Development (GAD) Fund.

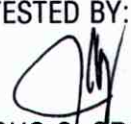
SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval and publication in the newspaper of general circulation in Metro Manila.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 27, SERIES OF 2019

Pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 738, S-2019, otherwise known as "AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING ALL SENIOR CITIZENS WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF MANDALUYONG CITY FROM THE PAYMENT OF PARKING FEES IN ALL PARKING AREAS OF BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS, MALLS, HOSPITALS OR ANY OTHER SIMILAR PLACES SITUATED WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF", upon recommendation of the concerned Committee, I, CARMELITA A. ABALOS, in my capacity as Mayor of Mandaluyong City, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, hereby adopt and promulgate the following rules and regulations:

IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 738, S-2019, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING ALL SENIOR CITIZENS WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF MANDALUYONG CITY FROM THE PAYMENT OF PARKING FEES IN ALL PARKING AREAS OF BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS, MALLS, HOSPITALS OR ANY OTHER SIMILAR PLACES SITUATED WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF"

**Rule I
COVERAGE AND EXCEPTIONS**

Section 1. Coverage. The privileges and benefits of this Ordinance shall be enjoyed by all senior citizens who are residents of Mandaluyong City.

Section 2. The Privilege. All senior citizens who are residents of Mandaluyong City are exempt from the payment of flat rate parking fees or the initial rate fee, if applicable, in parking areas of business establishments, malls, hospitals or any other similar places situated within the territorial jurisdiction of the City; Provided that, the privilege shall be availed by the senior citizen once a day only.

This privilege, however, shall not cover lost parking tickets issued by concerned business establishment.

Section 3. Exceptions. The privilege granted in this Ordinance shall not apply to:

- a. overnight parking;
- b. spaces or buildings devoted solely for parking and are not in any way connected with any business establishment; and
- c. valet parking.

**Rule II
PROCEDURE FOR AVAILMENT OF THE EXEMPTION**

Section 4. Procedure. To avail of the exemption, the senior citizen must:

- a. present his or her valid Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs (OSCA) Identification Card, or any government issued ID card and/or document establishing that the senior citizen is at least sixty (60) years of age and a resident of Mandaluyong City;
- b. at the cashier in the parking area of establishments, malls, hospitals and other similar places; and
- c. he or she must be passenger or driver of the motor vehicle.

**Rule III
PENALTY FOR VIOLATION**

Section 5. Violation and Penalties. Failure or refusal to extend the grant of exemption from payment of flat rate parking fees or the initial rate thereof under this Ordinance in favor of the resident senior citizen shall be considered a violation of this Ordinance.

In case of violation by the cashier, penalties shall be imprisonment of one (1) day to thirty (30) days, or a fine of Five Hundred Pesos (Php 500.00), or both at the discretion of the court.

In case of violation by carpark operator, manager and/or owner of the parking establishment, the penalties shall be imprisonment of one (1) day to thirty (30) days, or a fine of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00), or both at the discretion of the court.

**Rule IV
FILING A COMPLAINT**

Section 6. How initiated. The offended party may complain orally or in writing to the Lupon Chairman of the Barangay in whose jurisdiction the violation was committed.

Section 7. Procedure to be followed. The complaint shall undergo the process of mediation, conciliation or arbitration as provided for under the provisions of the Katarungan Pambarangay, under Chapter 7, Title One, Book III of Republic Act No. 7160 known as the Local Government Code of 1991, which shall govern the procedure on the initiation and filing of the formal complaint before the courts for violation of an Ordinance where there is a private offended party.

Section 8. No Contest Provision does not apply. For any violation under this Ordinance, no Ordinance Violation Receipt (OVR) shall be issued against the violator. Consequently, the No Contest Provision shall not apply pursuant to Section 1-A of Ordinance No. 705, S-2018.

**Rule V
MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS**

Section 9. Separability Clause. If for any reason, any part or provisions of this Implementing Rules and Regulations shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other sections or provision hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 10. Repealing Clause. Ordinance No. 726, S-2019 is expressly repealed. Any ordinance, resolution, rules and regulations or any part thereof which are in conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance and these rules and regulations are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 11. Suppletory Clause. All relevant laws and ordinances as well as existing rules and regulations, shall be deemed suppletory applicable to the Ordinance and its implementation.

Section 12. Effectivity. These Implementing Rules and Regulations shall take effect after thirty (30) days following its publication, together with the Ordinance, once in a newspaper of general circulation in Metro Manila.
