RESOLUTION NO. 3283, S-2023



A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG, THROUGH THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE VICTIMS OF FIRE THAT BURNED THE HOUSE STRUCTURES LOCATED AT BLOCK 6, LOT 11 ABELLA COMPOUND, BARANGAY MABINI J. RIZAL, MANDALUYONG CITY

WHEREAS, based on the validated fire disaster report of the Mandaluyong City Social Welfare and Development Department, in coordination with the Bureau of Fire Protection, on May 31, 2023 at about 3:16 A.M. a fire occurred at Block 6, Lot 11 Abella Compound, Barangay Mabini J. Rizal, Mandaluyong City, which broke out and spread to the affected area;

WHEREAS, based on the City Social Welfare and Development Department report, the fire incident rendered around Four (4) validated fire affected families or Seven (7) validated fire affected individuals, with one (1) casualty, as their houses were totally burned/damaged by the fire;

WHEREAS, it is the thrust of the City Government of Mandaluyong to provide sincere and efficient public service to its constituents, especially in times of crisis and emergencies, thus, deeming necessary to extend financial assistance to the affected families and individuals;

WHEREAS, the City Mayor, distraught by this fire disaster, has initiated to grant financial assistance to the affected families amounting to Eight Thousand Pesos (P8,000.00) per house owner (1 houseowner), Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) per house sharer (2 house sharers) and Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00) per house renter (1 house renter). The total amount of Twenty One Thousand Pesos (P21,000.00) financial assistance shall be chargeable against the Calamity Fund or Quick Response Fund of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF), subject to accounting and COA auditing laws, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, said grant of financial assistance to those affected fire victims merits the consideration of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong in accordance with the mandated duty of the City to help and promote the welfare of its constituents.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to authorize the City of Mandaluyong, through the Local Chief Executive, to grant financial assistance to the victims of fire that burned the house structures located at Block 6, Lot 11 Abella Compound, Barangay Mabini J. Rizal, Mandaluyong City.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copy of this Resolution be furnished the Honorable City Mayor at the Office of the Mayor, and the respective Mandaluyong City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MCDRRMO) and City Social Welfare and Development Department, for their immediate information and appropriate action.

ADOPTED on this 5th day of June 2023, in the City of Mandaluyong.


