RESOLUTION NO. 3534, S-2024

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE
INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF THE SPECIAL
HEALTH FUND IN THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG**

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution implores the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, Article XIII, Section 11 of the 1987 Constitution provides that the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development, which shall endeavor to make essential goods, health, and other social services available to the people at an affordable cost;

WHEREAS, Section 102 of Republic Act No. 7160 or the Local Government Code of 1991 lists one of the functions of the local health board as proposing to the Sangguniang Panlungsod annual budgetary allocations for the operation and maintenance of health facilities and services within the city, in accordance with standards and criteria set by the Department of Health;

WHEREAS, Section 3(b) of Republic Act No. 11223 or the Universal Health Care Act seeks to ensure that all Filipinos are guaranteed equitable access to quality and affordable health care goods and services, and protected against financial risk;

WHEREAS, Section 20 of Republic Act No. 11223 states that the city-wide health system shall pool and manage, through a special health fund, all resources intended for health services to finance population-based and individual-based health services, health system operating costs, capital investments, and remuneration of additional health workers and incentives for all health workers:

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2024, the Local Health Board of the City of Mandaluyong passed Resolution No. 2024-003 or A Resolution Supporting the Institutionalization of the Special Health Fund in the City of Mandaluyong and Providing Mechanisms for its Utilization, Monitoring, and Accountability;

WHEREAS, the Health Committee of the Sangguniang Panlungsod has reviewed the said Local Health Board Resolution through a public hearing and supports the institutionalization of a special health fund in the City of Mandaluyong, as well as the mechanisms for its utilization, monitoring, and accountability;

NOW, THEREFORE, and upon motion duly seconded by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Mandaluyong, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Mandaluyong approves the institutionalization of a special health fund in the City of Mandaluyong and the mechanisms for its utilization, monitoring, and accountability.
