RESOLUTION NO. 3591, S-2025

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HONORABLE MAYOR BENJAMIN S. ABALOS TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE CONSIGNMENT AGREEMENT WITH FOOD TERMINAL INCORPORATED FOR THE SUPPLY, PROVISION, AND REPLENISHMENT OF AFFORDABLE RICE STOCKS IN THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE “KADIWA NG PANGULO” RICE-FOR-ALL AND “P29” PROGRAMS OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code (LGC) provides that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Section 22 of the LGC, likewise, provides that every local government unit, as a corporation, shall have the power to enter into contracts, convey real properties, as well as exercise such other powers as are granted to corporations;

WHEREAS, local government units are mandated to ensure and support, among other things, promote health and safety and enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology;

WHEREAS, the involvement of local government units in the sustainability of measures geared towards food security is crucial, as access to affordable goods and commodities and delivery of nutritious food are factors heavily considered in determining the adaptability and growth in the local health sector;

WHEREAS, the nexus between the efforts initiated by the National Government and the need for an established mechanism to expand and widen the scope of measures in place relating to food security gave birth to the Kadiwa ng Pangulo “Rice-for-All” and “P29” program, which will market well-milled rice at an affordable price to the public, and provide affordable rice to the vulnerable sector by selling rice at P29 per kilo, respectively;

WHEREAS, participation of local government units in the implementation of food security measures is widely considered substantial, as they serve as catalysts in the local level for the implementation of programs initiated by the National Government;

WHEREAS, Food Terminal Incorporated is a government-owned and controlled corporation (GOCC) mandated to establish and operate a general market for producers, manufacturers, and farmers, encompassing, but not limited to, the wholesale buying, selling, trading, and dealing of groceries, provisions, foodstuffs, wares, vegetables, fruits, cereals, grains, and other agricultural products, as well as all other goods incidental to the operation of a general market, including meat, poultry, fish, bakery products, and related mercantile item;

WHEREAS, to facilitate the implementation of the programs, FTI seeks to collaborate with local government units, thus the preparation of a draft Consignment Agreement (“Agreement”) with the City of Mandaluyong;

WHEREAS, under the said Agreement, FTI shall supply several rice varieties to the City of Mandaluyong at a pre-determined price, with the latter handling the distribution and selling of the same to its constituents under specified vulnerable sectors;

WHEREAS, the City Government intends to enter into the Agreement and abide by its provisions, all towards the providing an established mode of purchase of rice varieties for its constituents;

WHEREAS, as reviewed by the City Legal Department, the Agreement appears to be reasonable as to their terms and responsive to the sought objectives by the City;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code requires that a Sanggunian Resolution be issued first before the Local Chief Executive may be authorized to sign contracts in representation of the local government unit.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to authorize the Honorable Mayor BENJAMIN S. ABALOS to enter into and sign the Consignment Agreement with the FOOD TERMINAL INCORPORATED for the supply, provision, and replenishment of affordable rice stocks in the City of Mandaluyong for the implementation of the "Kadiwa ng Pangulo" Rice-for-All and "P29" programs of the National Government.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Office of the Mayor, Food Terminal Incorporated, and other pertinent departments and offices of the City Government of Mandaluyong.
