ORDINANCE NO. 748, S-2019

AN AMENDED ORDINANCE GRANTING ONE
THOUSAND PESOS (PHP 1,000.00) MONTHLY
FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO SURVIVING SPOUSES
OF VETERANS IN THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 506, S-2012 granted One Thousand Pesos (₱1,000.00) monthly financial assistance to surviving spouses of veterans in the City of Mandaluyong which was enacted on October 15, 2012 by the Sangguniang Panlungsod;

WHEREAS, said Ordinance was enacted to provide additional benefit following the one shot deal benefit pursuant to Ordinance No. 394, S-2008, granting financial assistance to recognized war veterans & post mortuary assistance to legal heirs;

WHEREAS, following proper updating as of November 19, 2019, there are twenty-five (25) surviving spouses of war veterans who are actively participating in all related activities of the Veterans Federation of the Philippines - Mandaluyong and continue to carry on the beliefs and principles of their late husbands;

WHEREAS, this group composed of twenty five (25) surviving spouses of war veterans appealed for a monthly financial assistance to the Honorable City Mayor Carmelita A. Abalos;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Carmelita A. Abalos, out of compassion and mindful of the best interests of these surviving spouses for more years to live, they are being in their 80's and above, yielded to their request;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod is fully in accord with the generosity manifested by the City Mayor, thus, this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, in session assembled:

- SECTION 1. TITLE OF ORDINANCE. This Ordinance shall be known as the Financial Assistance Program to Surviving Spouses of War Veterans of the City of Mandaluyong.
- SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It shall be the policy of the local governance that the economic plight of the surviving spouses of war veterans of the City of Mandaluyong be also considered and addressed by giving assistance as a fitting recognition of their continued participation in all activities related to war veterans' affairs.
- SECTION 3. SCOPE OF COVERAGE. The following surviving bonafide spouses of the war veterans of the City of Mandaluyong shall be entitled to the monthly One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) financial assistance.

SECTION 4. ENTITLEMENT. All recognized surviving spouses of war veterans in the City of Mandaluyong included in the list above mentioned are entitled to ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) monthly financial assistance.

SECTION 5. TERMINATION OF ENTITLEMENT. It is understood that the financial assistance of the named beneficiaries or recipients shall be terminated once the **beneficiary/recipient** is out of the country; whatever monetary assistance due her during her absence is considered waived.

SECTION 6. FUNDING. The funds for this program shall come from the General Fund appropriated under the OFFICE OF THE SENIOR CITIZENS.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after publication at least once in a newspaper of general circulation in Metro Manila.

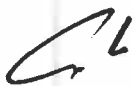
