



**RESOLUTION NO. 3786, S-2026**

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION – NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION TO WITHDRAW THE STAND-ALONE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL STATUS OF BONIFACIO JAVIER SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL AND RESTORE ITS STATUS AS BONIFACIO JAVIER NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL WITH JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL (SHS) PROGRAMS

WHEREAS, Bonifacio Javier Senior High School was established as a stand-alone Senior High School effective December 12, 2024, by virtue of Regional Order No. SHS-PU-007, s. 2024 issued by the Department of Education – National Capital Region;

WHEREAS, prior to its conversion into a stand-alone Senior High School, the institution operated as Bonifacio Javier National High School, offering both Junior High School (JHS) and Senior High School (SHS) programs;

WHEREAS, consultations were conducted among school officials, teaching and non-teaching personnel, parents, students, barangay officials, and other stakeholders regarding the present status of the school;

WHEREAS, arising from these consultations, stakeholders collectively expressed support for the withdrawal of its stand-alone Senior High School status and the restoration of its former integrated structure due to compelling reasons and other cogent circumstances;

WHEREAS, the withdrawal of its stand-alone Senior High School status would restore its status as Bonifacio Javier National High School, a junior high school with Senior High School offerings, thereby enabling the school to accept Grade 7 learners and establish a sustainable baseline source of future Grade 11 enrollees;

WHEREAS, current enrollment data of Bonifacio Javier Senior High School shows an alarming decline in the number of Senior High School learners from School Year 2024–2025 to School Year 2025–2026, including results from early registration indicating a continuing downward trend, largely attributed to the complete phase-out of its Junior High School program;

WHEREAS, there is a pressing need to restore the Junior High School level in order to sustain and stabilize enrollment in the Senior High School program;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9143, approved on July 30, 2001, which converted the school into Bonifacio Javier National High School as a junior high school, remains in full force and effect, thereby providing legal basis for its restoration;

WHEREAS, letters from Barangay Officials and parents of learners from Barangay Barangka Drive, where the school is located, strongly request that the school resume acceptance of Grade 7 learners for School Year 2026–2027 to prevent students from traveling long distances for their daily schooling;

WHEREAS, the restoration of Bonifacio Javier National High School as an integrated secondary school is essential to ensure accessibility, continuity of education, and responsiveness to the needs of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion and duly seconded, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to respectfully request the Department of Education – National Capital Region to withdraw the stand-alone Senior High School status of Bonifacio Javier Senior High School.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the Department of Education – National Capital Region be requested to restore the school's former status as Bonifacio Javier National High School, offering both Junior High School and Senior High School (SHS) programs.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the restored school be authorized to accept Grade 7 learners beginning School Year 2026–2027.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Department of Education – National Capital Region, the Schools Division Office of Mandaluyong City, the School Administration of Bonifacio Javier Senior High School, and other concerned offices for their information and appropriate action.
