ORDINANCE NO. 264, S-2003

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING ACACIA LANE TO
ANASTACIO S. MARTINEZ STREET,
MANDALUYONG CITY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session assembled:

WHEREAS, Acacia Lane, a short stretch of city road linking Shaw Boulevard to the main entrance of the then Welfareville, a government institution that is then being managed by the Social Welfare Administration (SWA) now Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), is about two hundred six (206) linear meters of first class road located at Barangay Hagdang Bato Libis, this City;

WHEREAS, it was made known as such for reason of the planted acacia trees on both sides of the road which are now grown up that shades promenaders then and now from going to and from the Welfareville Compound, and it was the late owner/donor of the Welfareville property, DR. JOSE FABELLA, JORGE VARGAS and other illustrious sons of Mandaluyong, who coined up the name of the road as Acacia Lane which from then on to the present was known as such;

WHEREAS, there is a better proposition of renaming Acacia Lane into ANASTACIO S. MARTINEZ Street, as a fitting tribute to an illustrious son of Hagdang Bato Libis, this City, who rose from a mere vendor/cochero during his childhood days to become a Certified Public Accountant and Lawyer and was once elected number one (1) Councilor of this City in 1959 when it was still known as the Municipality of Mandaluyong, Province of Rizal;

WHEREAS, it was during the time of ANASTACIO S. MARTINEZ as Councilor when he authored several ordinances that levy taxes on tobacco and other processed products manufactured and/or sold in Mandaluyong, thus, it was the beginning of the influx of industrialization and commercial activities in Mandaluyong;


WHEREAS, the renaming of Acacia Lane to ANASTACIO S. MARTINEZ is a fitting tribute to the late Councilor with the end in view of perpetuating his legacies and memories for the present and future generations of Mandaluyong to be made known.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED as it is hereby ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod, that Acacia Lane be renamed as ANASTACIO S. MARTINEZ Street.

FURTHER, ordained that let a copy of this Ordinance be forwarded to the National Historical Commission (NHC), the Philippine Postal Corporation for its information and reference.
