RESOLUTION NO. 3796, S-2026

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE COMPREHENSIVE
LOCAL JUVENILE INTERVENTION
PROGRAM (CLJIP) 2025–2027 OF THE
CITY OF MANDALUYONG**

WHEREAS, the Local Council for the Protection of Children (LCPC) is mandated to promote and ensure the welfare of children in accordance with national and international laws, policies, and issuances;

WHEREAS, among the legal bases is Republic Act No. 9344, otherwise known as the “Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act of 2006,” as amended by Republic Act No. 10630, which provides for a comprehensive juvenile justice and welfare system;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the policies of the Juvenile Justice and Welfare Council (JJWC), local government units are directed to formulate and implement their respective Comprehensive Local Juvenile Intervention Program (CLJIP);

WHEREAS, the CLJIP 2025–2027 of the City of Mandaluyong aims to ensure the effective and efficient implementation of intervention programs, while strengthening awareness and intensifying efforts toward the protection of children against abuse, exploitation, and discrimination;

WHEREAS, the adoption of the said program is essential as part of the City’s compliance with the Child-Friendly Local Governance Audit (CFLGA);

WHEREAS, the LCPC of the City of Mandaluyong has formally requested the Sangguniang Panlungsod to adopt the said program;

NOW, THEREFORE, on a motion duly seconded, be it RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to adopt the Comprehensive Local Juvenile Intervention Program (CLJIP) 2025–2027 of the City of Mandaluyong, including its corresponding plans, tables, and annexes, as the basis for juvenile protection initiatives of the City, in coordination with the City Social Welfare and Development Department (CSWDD);

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the recommendations and strategies of the said program shall be implemented, including:

- a. continuation and strengthening of case referral systems;
- b. continuation and strengthening of the Parent Effectiveness Service (PES);
- c. intensification of campaigns and implementation of relevant ordinances on parental responsibility and child protection;
- d. establishment of outposts to monitor areas;

- e. strengthening the functionality of the Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC);
- f. continuation of coordination with partner agencies and support groups; and
- g. continuation of trainings and seminars for service providers.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the CSWDD is hereby directed to:

- a. prepare a consolidated operational plan, including budget estimates and resource mobilization strategies; and
- b. conduct training and capacity-building workshops for LCPC members, child representatives, and frontline workers on child protection case management and child-sensitive protocols;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the CSWDD shall prepare and submit annual progress reports on the implementation of this Resolution to the LCPC and the Sangguniang Panlungsod, and ensure that a consolidated annual report is made publicly available, including monitoring indicators on service coverage, case outcomes, and other relevant data;

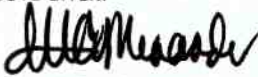
RESOLVED FURTHER, that the inclusion of the necessary appropriations in the next supplemental or annual budget is hereby authorized to support the implementation of the approved operational plan;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the CSWDD is encouraged to pursue partnerships with national agencies, non-government organizations (NGOs), the private sector, and development partners for technical assistance, capacity-building, and resource support, and to harmonize local policies with national standards and best practices;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution be furnished to the Office of the City Mayor, LCPC Secretariat, CSWDD, and other concerned offices for their information and appropriate action.
