RESOLUTION NO. 3742, S-2026

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG, THROUGH THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, HONORABLE CITY MAYOR CARMELITA A. ABALOS, TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE VICTIMS WHO SUFFERED WATER DAMAGE DUE TO THE FIRE THAT OCCURRED ON FEBRUARY 11, 2026 AT BLOCK 34, BARANGAY ADDITION HILLS, MANDALUYONG CITY

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2026 at about 4:15 A.M., a fire occurred at Block 34, Barangay Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City, causing damage to several residential structures and affecting numerous families;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong previously adopted Resolution No. 3739, S-2026 entitled: A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG, THROUGH THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, HONORABLE CITY MAYOR CARMELITA A. ABALOS, TO GRANT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE VICTIMS OF FIRE THAT OCCURRED ON FEBRUARY 11, 2026 AT BLOCK 34, BARANGAY ADDITION HILLS, MANDALUYONG CITY;

WHEREAS, validation conducted by the City Social Welfare and Development Department confirmed that Forty Two (42) families sustained water damage as a result of the firefighting operations during the said fire incident;

WHEREAS, it is the thrust of the City Government of Mandaluyong to provide sincere and efficient public service to its constituents, especially in times of crisis and emergencies, thus, deeming necessary to extend financial assistance to the affected families and individuals;

WHEREAS, in order to provide equitable assistance, the City Mayor has recommended the grant of financial assistance in the amount of Three Thousand Pesos (₱3,000.00) per family to Fourteen (14) validated water-damaged families who were adversely affected during the fire disaster response operations, as their houses were inundated with water and their personal belongings were consequently damaged or destroyed, for a total amount of Forty Two Thousand Pesos (₱42,000.00), chargeable against the Calamity Fund or Quick Response Fund of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF), subject to existing accounting and Commission on Audit (COA) laws, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, the grant of financial assistance to the affected water-damaged families merits the consideration and approval of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong in accordance with the City's mandate to help and promote the general welfare of its constituents.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to authorize the City of Mandaluyong, through the Local Chief Executive, Honorable City Mayor Carmelita A. Abalos, to grant financial assistance to the victims who suffered water damage due to the fire that occurred on February 11, 2026 at Block 34, Barangay Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copy of this Resolution be furnished the Honorable City Mayor CARMELITA A. ABALOS at the Office of the City Mayor, and the respective Mandaluyong City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Department (MCDRRMD) and City Social Welfare and Development Department, for their immediate information and appropriate action.
