ORDINANCE NO. 742, S-2019

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF ALLOWANCES
TO CERTAIN NATIONAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES
STATIONED IN OR ASSIGNED TO THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG
CONTRIBUTING TO THE EFFICIENT AND EFFECTIVE
ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE

WHEREAS, it is a declared policy under the 1987 Constitution that territorial and political subdivisions of the Republic of the Philippines such as the City of Mandaluyong, enjoy local autonomy;

WHEREAS, the Congress enacted Republic Act No. 7160 as amended, otherwise known as the "*Local Government Code of 1991*" providing a system of decentralization, and allocating among the different local government units their powers, responsibilities, and resources, and provide for the qualifications, election, appointment and removal, term, salaries, powers and functions and duties of local officials, and all other matters relating to their organization and operation;

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the invaluable contribution of judges and prosecutors stationed in or assigned to this City in moral and social development through the efficient and effective administration of justice;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 458 (a)(1)(xi) of R.A. No. 7160, the *Sangguniang Panlungsod* has the power to approve ordinances and pass resolutions for an efficient and effective city government, and in this connection, shall, when the finances of the city government allow, provide for additional allowances and other benefits to judges, prosecutors and public elementary and high school teachers, and other national government officials stationed in or assigned to the City.

BE IT ENACTED by the *Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Mandaluyong* in session assembled:

SECTION 1. The City grants the following national government officials and employees stationed in or assigned to this City allowances, in addition to their salaries provided under our laws, as follows:

- b.) A prosecutor rendering service in this City as a duly designated Review Prosecutor, regardless of rank, shall receive an emolument/allowance equivalent to a Senior Assistant City Prosecutor;
- c.) Prosecutors from the Office of the Prosecutor General, Regions, Provinces and other Cities, regardless of rank, and detailed to this City, shall be entitled to an emolument/allowance equivalent to ₱12,000.00 x (5) = ₱60,000.00

SECTION 3. The subject allowances granted by the abovementioned national government officials and employees shall be given every month, provided that the City has available funds for the purpose; Provided further, that the amount to be given may be increased or decreased subject to the discretion of the City to ensure its genuine and meaningful autonomy;

SECTION 4. The grant thereof shall be presented in City's budget under the Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses pursuant to item 5.5 of Local Budget Circular No. 75 dated July 12, 2002;

SECTION 5. The sum of ONE MILLION THREE HUNDRED THIRTEEN THOUSAND PESOS (P1,313,000.00) a month is hereby provided and allotted, subject to applicable accounting and auditing laws, rules and regulations.

SECTION 6. The abovementioned national government officials and employees concerned shall receive the subject allowances as long as they remain to be stationed in or assigned in the city, and shall automatically discontinue upon retirement, death, termination or transfer to another local government unit.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or resolutions inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall retroactively take effect on August 1, 2019.

ADOPTED on this 23rd day of September, 2019, in the City of Mandaluyong.

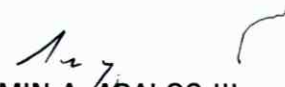
