ORDINANCE NO. 205, S-1999

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING MANDALUYONG
HIGH SCHOOL (MAUWAY ANNEX) AT NUEVE DE
FEBRERO STREET, BARANGAY MAUWAY THIS CITY
TO MANDALUYONG CITY EAST HIGH SCHOOL

EXPLANATORY NOTES

WHEREAS, Section 13, paragraph (5) sub-paragraph (e) of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that "a change of name of a public school shall be made only upon the recommendation of the local School Board concerned";

WHEREAS, Section 99 paragraph (d) of the Local Government Code of 1991 recognizes the recommendatory privilege of the School Board on such changing of names of public schools;

WHEREAS, on March 16, 1999, the Mandaluyong School Board passed a Resolution unanimously endorsing the creation of the MANDALUYONG CITY EAST HIGH SCHOOL invoking further the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS) Order No. 69, Series of 1993 wherein the Department of Education, Culture and Sports, encourages the establishments of high schools initially among public schools for more intensive and advanced secondary education program;

WHEREAS, there is only one (1) public high school in this division that offers regular secondary school curriculum which can accommodate one thousand five hundred (1,500) students yearly thus; of the approximately 5,000 elementary school graduates from public and private schools yearly, 3,500 of these will be dislocated;

WHEREAS, it is admitted that last October 10, 1996, Resolution No. 512, S-1996 was passed by the Sangguniang Panlungsod endorsing the conversion of the Mandaluyong High School (Mauway Annex) in Mandaluyong City into a separate high school to be known as MANDALUYONG CITY EAST HIGH SCHOOL;

ORDINANCE NO. 205, S-1999

BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong, in session assembled, upon motion duly seconded, that:

SECTION 1. The Mandaluyong High School (MAUWAY ANNEX) located at Nueve de Febrero Street, Barangay Mauway, this City shall, henceforth be named MANDALUYONG CITY EAST HIGH SCHOOL.

SECTION 2. Let copies of this Ordinance be forwarded to the Secretary of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS), Honorable NEPTALI M. GONZALES II, congressman/representative of the Lone District of Mandaluyong, Congress of the Philippines and the National Historical Commission.

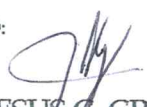
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SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval.

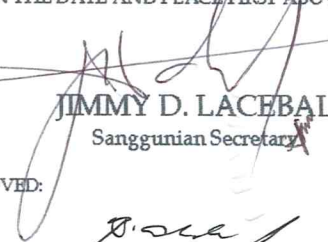

Dear Atty. Lacibal:

This is with reference to Ordinance No. 204, S-1999 entitled "An Ordinance Establishing a Second Health Center for Brgy. Addition Hills".

A perusal of said Ordinance suggests that the objective for the construction of a health center is highly commendable. In fact, the undersigned City Mayor has even manifested his desire to construct said health center. However, pertinent laws restrict us from implementing the same on the ground that the said site is not owned by the City Government of Mandaluyong but by the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), a national government instrumentality. By virtue of which, I seriously doubt if we can implement this ordinance without being sanctioned or penalized by agency concerned.

Perhaps, it would be best to first make a council resolution requesting DSWD to allow the City Government of Mandaluyong to construct a structure within said premises. Then, only after consent is granted by the proper authority would the project be implemented.

Please be guided accordingly.
