



RESOLUTION NO. 3777, S-2026

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE CARMELITA A. ABALOS, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN THE DATA TURN-OVER AGREEMENT (DTA), FOR AND IN BEHALF OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MANDALUYONG, WITH PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY (PSA) REPRESENTED BY ITS REGIONAL DIRECTOR, PACIANO B. DIZON, FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF COMMUNITY-BASED MONITORING SYSTEM (CBMS) IN THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG

WHEREAS, the Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) was established and instituted in every city and municipality as an economic and social tool for the formulation and implementation of poverty alleviation and development programs that are specific, targeted and responsive to the basic needs of each sector of the community pursuant to Republic Act 11315 or the Community-Based Monitoring System Act;

WHEREAS, on July 3, 2024, the City Government of Mandaluyong and Philippine Statistic Authority (PSA) entered into an agreement pursuant to PSA Board Resolution No. 04, Series of 2024, for the simultaneous conduct of the Census of Population and Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) stating therein their obligations in Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) which has the following expected outputs:

- a.) Implementation of Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) in the city/municipality;
- b.) Generation training, generation of statistical tables and poverty maps, and local-level planning and budgeting;
- c.) Establishment of Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) Databank;
- d.) Generation of statistical tables and thematic maps using Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) data for local plans;
- e.) Integration of Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) data in the local governance processes such as but not limited to local planning, investment programming, budgeting, program identification, and implementation, as well as disaster risk reduction and management measures; and
- f.) Documentation of Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) implementation, best practices and lessons learned;

WHEREAS, RA 11315 provides that the cities and municipalities are allowed to maintain their own Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) database for use in local-level planning and program implementation. The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) shall receive and store all aggregated data gathered by the cities and municipalities to create a nation Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) databank;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA), as the lead agency in the implementation of Republic Act 11315, shall undertake measures to ensure the integrity and safety of the gathered information against unnecessary leakage and access by unauthorized persons;

WHEREAS, the City Legal Officer has reviewed the pertinent documents related to this matter and has duly certified that the agreement is in order and not contrary to existing laws, rules, and regulations and that the City Mayor may sign the same.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG, AND BY VIRTUE OF THE POWERS VESTED IN IT BY LAW, in a session duly assembled, to authorize the City Mayor, Honorable Carmelita A. Abalos, to enter into a Data Turnover Agreement (DTA) with Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) for the implementation and utilization of Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) data.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that in compliance to the Data Privacy Act, Custodians of the documents, records, data or information shall ensure the utmost confidentiality of the same, in compliance with the Republic Act No. 10173 or the Data Privacy Act of 2012.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the authority, issuance and approval hereof are subject to, and conditioned upon, full compliance with all existing laws, circulars, issuances, memoranda, and rules and regulations.
