ORDINANCE NO. 777, S-2020

AN ORDINANCE LIFTING THE LIQUOR BAN IN THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG THEREBY AMENDING SECTIONS 1 AND 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 763, S-2020 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY BANNING THE SALE AND DELIVERY, AND REGULATING THE CONSUMPTION OF LIQUOR IN THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG TO PROMOTE SOCIAL DISTANCING"

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, City Ordinance No. 763, S-2020 was passed and approved temporarily banning the sale and delivery of liquor as well as regulating its consumption in Mandaluyong City during the Enhanced Community Quarantine;

WHEREAS, the temporary liquor ban sought to promote social distancing during the quarantine period by preventing mass gatherings and decreasing person-to-person contact in order to slow down the spread of COVID-19;

WHEREAS, the National Capital Region (NCR) was recently placed under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine from May 16, 2020 to May 31, 2020;

WHEREAS, the liquor ban in the City, though temporary in nature, has greatly affected the domestic liquor industry, especially the livelihood of employees, workers, sari-sari stores, and other small business establishments depending on it;

WHEREAS, there is a possibility that if the ban continues, the industry may not survive leading not only to the unemployment and displacement of many employees and workers, but also affecting the benefits that it brings to the Philippine economy;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Mandaluyong is aware of the duty and responsibility to strike a balance between the health of its people and the survival of businesses in the city;

WHEREAS, after two months of hiatus due to quarantine, there is a need to assist local industries, like liquor, to thrive in their businesses and contribute in refueling our economy;

WHEREAS, on the other hand, the stricter enforcement of City Ordinances banning consumption of liquor in public places and mandatory wearing of face masks or coverings will promote the stringent physical and social distancing imposed by the National Government during this time of pandemic.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Mandaluyong, in session assembled:

Section 1. TITLE – This Ordinance shall be known as an Ordinance Lifting the Liquor Ban in the City of Mandaluyong during the Enhanced Community Quarantine.

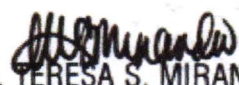
Section 2. The temporary ban on the sale and delivery of alcohol, wine, beer, liquor and other intoxicating beverages in Mandaluyong City during the enhanced community quarantine is hereby lifted; Provided that, the regulation, restriction and limitation on consumption of liquor under Section 3 of Ordinance No. 763, S-2020 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 763, S-2020 is hereby amended or modified accordingly.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after approval.
