ORDINANCE NO. 811, S-2020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8 OF ORDINANCE NO. 779, S-2020, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY MINIMUM FARE OF TWENTY PESOS (P20.00) IN THE DURATION OF THE MODIFIED ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (MECQ), GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (GCQ), MODIFIED GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (MGCQ) OR OTHER COMMUNITY QUARANTINE AS MAY BE IMPOSED BY THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT IN THE CITY OF MANDALUYONG AND PRESCRIBING GUIDELINES IN THE OPERATIONS AND CONDUCT OF TRICYCLES UNDER THE 'NEW NORMAL' COMPLYING TO THE SAFETY TRANSPORT PROTOCOLS OF THE INTER-AGENCY TASK FORCE" AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

WHEREAS, on May 27, 2020, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Mandaluyong enacted Ordinance No. 779, S-2020 entitled: "An Ordinance Establishing a Temporary Minimum Fare of Twenty Pesos (P20.00) in the duration of the Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ), General Community Quarantine (GCQ), Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) or Other Community Quarantine as may be imposed by the National Government in the City of Mandaluyong and Prescribing Guidelines in the Operations and Conduct of Tricycles under the 'New Normal' complying to the Safety Transport Protocols of the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF)";

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned Ordinance is in line with the transportation protocols and guidelines set by the Department of Transportation (DOTr) and the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases (IATF-EID) for "new normal" situation for Public Transport Operations on roads which includes all types of Tricycles, transport terminals, and operators regarding safety, capacity, and coverage/scope;

WHEREAS, under Section 8 of Ordinance No. 779, S-2020, it states therein that, any person violating Sections 3, 4 and 5 of this Ordinance will be meted with a fine of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per violation without prejudice to the application of Ordinance No. 767, S-2020, as amended by Ordinance No. 795, S-2020 otherwise known as the "Mandatory Wearing of Face Masks Ordinance", and imposing penalties for violations thereof;

WHEREAS, recently, the association of operators and drivers of tricycles and e-trikes in Mandaluyong City clamored for the amendment of Section 8 of Ordinance No. 779, S-2020 as most of them encountered economic difficulty during this period of pandemic;



WHEREAS, in the exercise of the jurisdiction of the City Government of Mandaluyong over tricycle operations and as it sympathizes with its constituents in these trying times of economic hardship and therefore finds it proper to reduce the penalty for violations of Sections 3, 4 and 5 of Ordinance No. 779, S-2020.



NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Mandaluyong, in session assembled:



SECTION 1. Amendment to Section 8 of Ordinance No. 779, S-2020. - Section 8 of Ordinance No. 779, S-2020 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“Section 8. Penalties. Any person violating Sections 3, 4, and 5 of this Ordinance shall suffer the penalty of:



First offense	Fine of One Hundred Pesos (P100.00)
Second offense	Fine of Two Hundred Pesos (P200.00)
Third offense	Fine of Three Hundred Pesos (P300.00)
Subsequent offenses	Fine of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) Or imprisonment of one (1) week, or both, at the discretion of the Court.”



per violation without prejudice to the application of Ordinance No. 767, S-2020, as amended by Ordinance 795, S-2020, otherwise known as the “Mandatory Wearing of Face Masks Ordinance” in the violation of Section 4, letter c (1 & 2) and the Bayanihan to Heal as One Act in other cases not covered by this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances and Resolutions or any part thereof which are inconsistent with the foregoing provision are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.



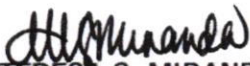
SECTION 3. Let copy of this Ordinance be furnished the Office of the City Mayor, City Traffic and Parking Management Department, Anti-Vice Division, Public Order and Safety Division, Mayor’s Action Command and other offices concerned for their information, guidance and reference.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and after publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Metro Manila, and shall continue to be enforced until the cessation of the State of Public Health Emergency due to COVID-19, or unless sooner lifted by the Sangguniang Panlungsod through an Ordinance.

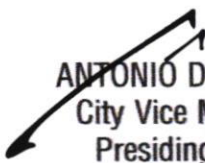
